  - i. Confirmed that the Scholastic dollars from last year's book fair is ours to spend.
  - ii. Scholastic did advise us that we can host a virtual book fair, but since the students won't have the same benefits as an in-person event, we are going to hope for a Spring book fair.
- b. Spirit Wear

  - i. We have begun backpacking the gift cards to families. Thus far we have \$180 in profit.
