6. Community Reports

- a. Supervisor's Report (Pat Pillon)
 - i. Band & Chorus has begun again & is going really well.
 - ii. Drama club had over 20 students try out for our virtual play
 - iii. The National Geography Bee will be held virtual
 - iv. Angie Mikula will lead an Art Club, coming soon
 - v. The Spring concert will be held outdoors
 - vi. Sports are scheduled to begin in April
 - vii. Kids will begin full day instruction on April 26th
 - 1. DTS re-start plan is posted on their webpage
 - 2. A FAQ will be sent to all parents shortly
 - viii. DTS is making plans to hold a "Summer Academy" which will be a 3-4 week program a few days / week where students will meet with teachers for continued education
 - ix. Test scores have been received and our benchmark testing is right on level compared to last year.
- b. BOE Report (Cathy Pouria)
 - i. The BOE has voted to go back to school, full day on April 26th as long as the County is in "yellow" territory for 2 weeks.
 - ii. 94% of parents want their children to return full day & in person
 - iii. Lunch will take place in the classrooms and rotate to the cafeteria, outside and other larger areas of the school.
 - iv. BOE is currently working on the 2021-2022 budget
 - v. DTS is looking to hire a principal position for the next school year
 - vi. DTS is also looking to put together a "Green Team" to make our school more sustainable

 - i. Spring Baseball & Softball to begin 4/24/21
 - ii. Spring Soccer to start 4/10/21
 - iii. The same guidelines will be in place as the Fall.
 - iv. For every event, parents must complete a covid questionnaire on TeamSnap.
 - v. Snack Shack will be open with packaged food
 - vi. The new scoreboard will be formally unveiled on Opening Day of baseball
 - vii. Tim Drew, DTAA President, will be stepping down. DTAA is currently looking for someone to take over.
